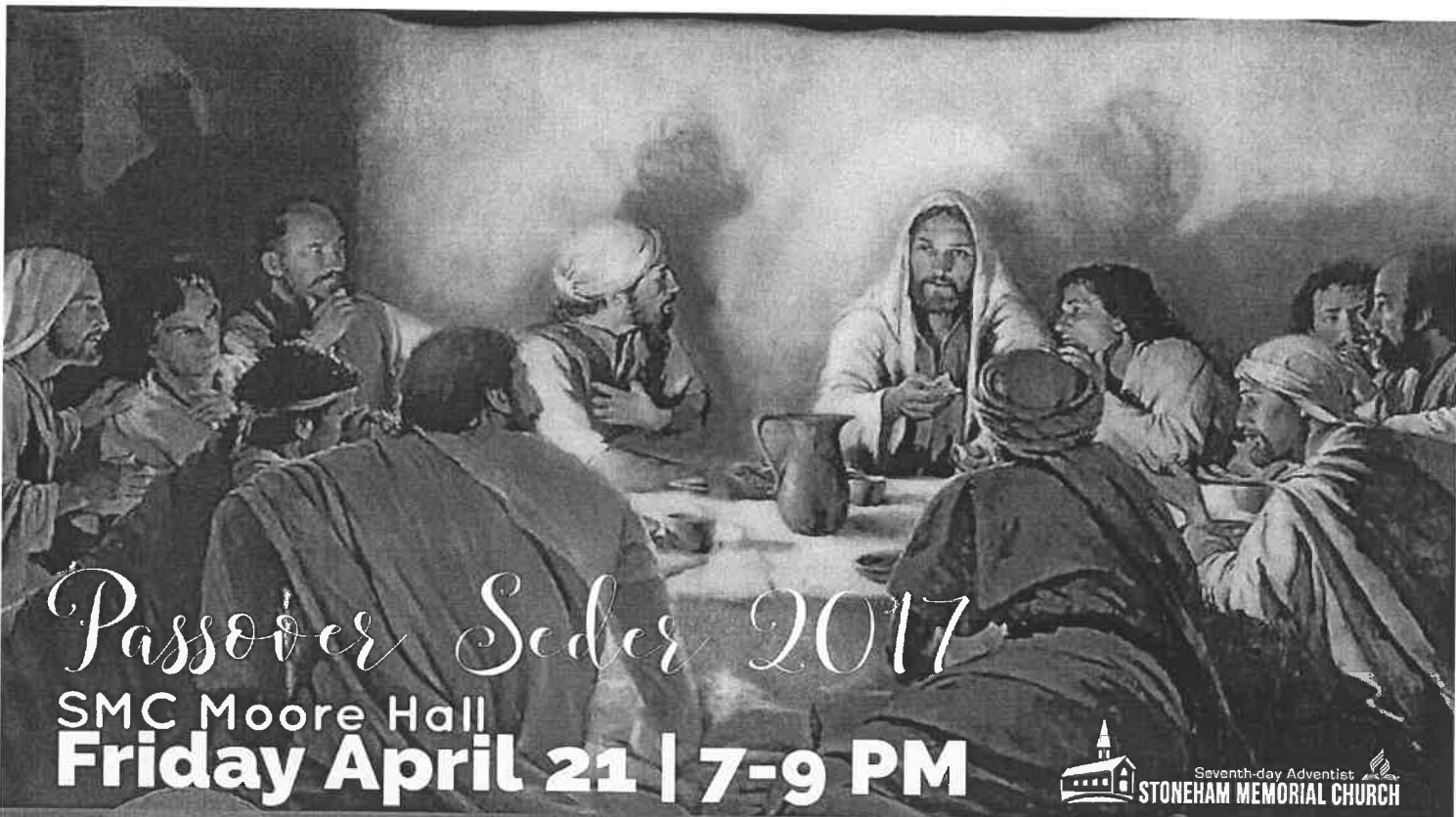
Spring is Here!—and so is Passover and Easter

Passover is the first biblical Feast of the Spring cycle (Exodus 12:18-28, Leviticus 23:5) and prescribed that each Israelite family sacrifice a young lamb as a memorial of Israel's miraculous deliverance from Egypt. During the final day of his life on earth Jesus kept a Passover meal in anticipation of his own sacrifice on the Cross. In symbolizing Jesus' inauguration of the New Covenant, Paul mentions in 1Cor 5:7 that "Christ our passover is sacrificed for us." Therefore, as Christians we are privileged to examine the Passover Feast as a symbol of our own deliverance from the power of sin and fear of death (See Heb 2:14-15: "Since the children have flesh and blood, he too shared in their humanity so that by his death he might destroy him who holds the power of death—that is, the devil—and free those who all their lives were held in slavery by their fear of death").

On Friday and Sabbath, April 21st and 22nd we'll be hosting Alexander Bolotnikov for a Passover celebration service. Alexander is director of the Shalom Learning Center, an educational institution of the North American Division, dedicated to helping churches reach out and build bridges with the Jewish community and to gain a fuller appreciation for the Hebraic heritage of the Christian faith.

Friday evening, April 21st at 7:00 pm Alexander will be leading participants in a Passover Seder meal in Moore Hall. This is a special ritual meal that Jews around the world celebrate each Spring, and in which Christians find special meaning. A sign-up sheet for the Seder meal is available in the Foyer.

Following the Passover Seder meal on Friday evening, Alexander will lead our worship Sabbath morning, April 22nd. After our Fellowship meal at 2:00 pm, Alexander will be available for further discussion, including a question and answer session.
