Organ Prelude: Gabriel Faure (1845-1924): *Cantique de Jean Racine* Op. 11

Organ Postlude: J S Bach (1685-1750): Fugue BWV 540

Cantique de Jean Racine (Chant by Jean Racine), [Op. 11](#), is a composition for mixed choir and piano or [organ](#) by [Gabriel Fauré](#), here in organ transcription. The text, "Verbe égal au Très-Haut" ("Word, one with the Highest") is a prayer to the 'Incarnate Word' the One equal with God, written by the young Faure for a competition held just before he graduated from the École Niedermeyer, a school in Paris for training in classical and religious music.

Bach's Fugue BWV 540, counterpart to the Toccata, his only throughout double fugue, is filled with chromaticism and dissonances. Two fugue subjects are exposed in separate sections and then combined in a moment of contrapuntal majesty. Listen for the moment in the final bars when the opening falling chromatic fugue subject enters in the mighty bass line of the pedals, like a Power which cannot be ignored, in the same vein with the prayer we heard at the beginning.
