Today's organ music:

Prelude: J. S. Bach (1685-1750): Schmücke dich, o liebe Seele, BWV 654

Here is Bach in his last years, meditating on a hymn composed by Johann Cruger in 1659, known to us as 'Deck thyself, my soul, with gladness'. The affect is of hopeful optimism, that the soul will get ready to receive the light of the divine presence and the bread of life. The feel is dance-like, and there is beauty in the unexpected harmonic twists, and the subtle ornamentation of the chorale melody.

Postlude: J. S Bach: Prelude in D Major, BWV 532

This is music composed around 1710, illustrating the young composer's style of learning: self guided study of different musical styles, combining them in a cohesive and most perfect way, which was described by contemporaries as: 'strange... new... expressive... beautiful'. The use of the pedals suggests why witnesses described it as feet 'ran over the pedals with this same facility, as if his feet had wings, making the organ resound with such fullness, and so penetrate the ears of those present like a thunderbolt'.

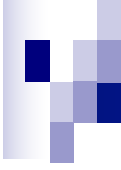
