Organ Prelude: Louis Vierne (1870-1937): Berceuse, from 24 Pièces en style libre op 31, No.19
Louis Vierne was born nearly blind, and after studying at the Paris Conservatory was appointed organist of Notre Dame in Paris in 1900. Berceuse is one of the most beloved pieces of the collection written for organ or harmonium, and is dedicated to his daughter Colette.

Organ Postlude: Johann Sebastian Bach (1685-1750): Fugue in F Major, BWV 540
BWV 540 is a double fugue, which means Bach had to develop two musical themes which must work in invertible counterpoint with each other. First theme develops a vocal musical idea in all four voices while the second theme appears to be playful, dance-like. Listen for the powerful combination of both themes towards the close of the fugue.
