Organ Prelude: Johann Sebastian Bach (1685-1750): Preludium in G Minor for Organ BWV 535

Here we see the young Bach using what was going to become a favorite method: composing an early work, then coming back to 'recycle' it as part of another composition, or as in this case, completing it with a fugue. The prelude bears resemblance in style to Buxtehude, and could have been written shortly after Bach visited Buxtehude and overstayed his vacation by more than one month leading to him being placed in house arrest for another month by the 'offended' city council.

As he never undertook formal studies of composition, Bach was considered the ultimate 'learned musician' who would familiarize himself with the style and works of another composer (Buxtehude, Bohm, Lubeck, Couperin, Vivaldi among a few) and then compose in their style, producing works of a quality that the original composers would not even have dreamed of, and ending up by assimilating elements of their style in what was to become his own musical language.

Organ Postlude: Fugue in G Minor for Organ BWV 535

In the Fugue in G Minor attached to this Prelude, Bach created three quasi-improvised movements, with an exciting middle movement where the hands keep switching keyboards and the music descends the whole scale in semitones. Just before that, there is a phrase in the pedal that Bach seized on (probably some years later) for his three-voice fugue. The theme accelerates through the use of ever shorter notes and the responses also become livelier throughout the piece, especially in the final use of the theme in the pedal. With a few virtuoso streams of notes as a coda, Bach repeats elements from the prelude as in a look back in time to the years of his youth.
