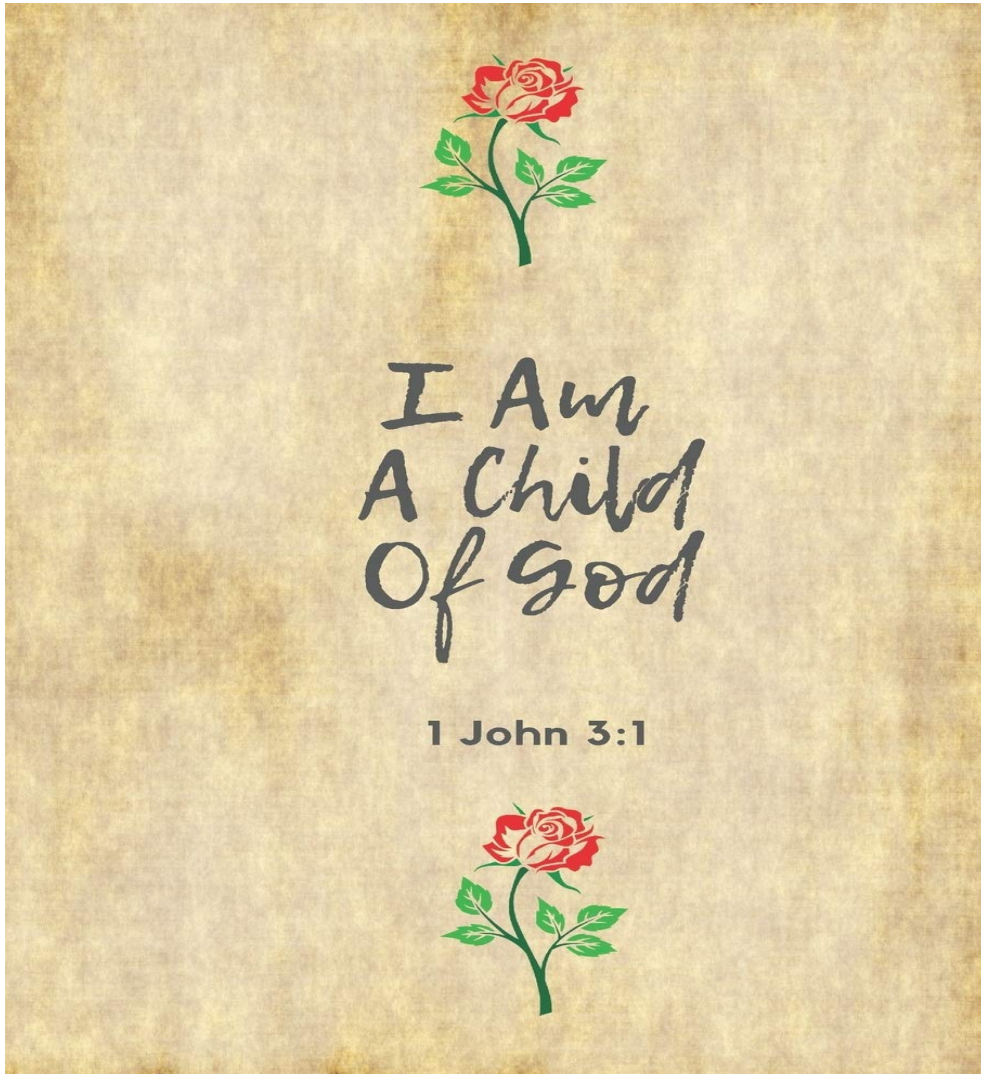

Today's Organ Music

With the beginning of the mature phase in Bach's works, one can see a calculating mind at work. Each bar is meticulously worked out, each has its own purpose and schematic identity. Much of Bach's music could be described as striving for perfection in what is a truly imperfect world. Bach knew too well the dramatic impetus which could be created by a duel between consonance and dissonance in order to create a 'well sounding harmony... for the glory of God and the permissible delight of the soul'. He considered that 'Dissonances are the night, consonances are the day; the light would never again be as pleasant, if it was always day and never night.

Dissonances are the winter, consonances the summer. The one is bitter, the other sweet'. His attention to details is clearly illustrated by how carefully even the less important passages are worked out; not one bar is wasted. The Fugue in G Major, BWV 541 (written around 1712) is without doubt one of the most sublime examples of contrapuntal architecture, lite hearted and energetic from start to end, with rhythms suggesting feelings of joy and beatific peace.

It is contrasted today with the Fantasia in G Minor, BWV 542 (written around 1720) with its incredible dissonances and incredible rhetoric.
