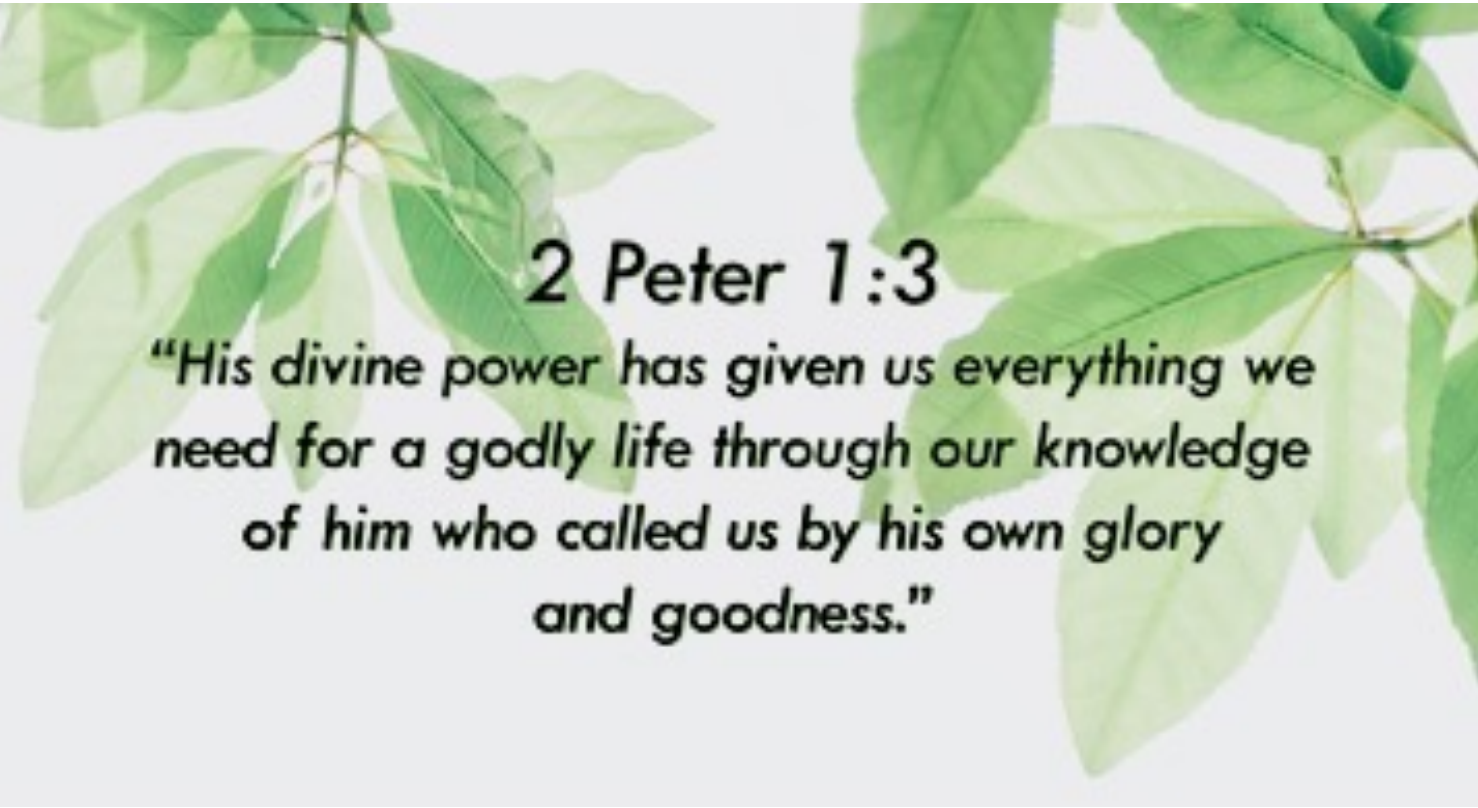

Organ Prelude: Johann Sebastian Bach (1685-1750) - Prelude in B Minor, BWV 544 for organ

Organ Postlude: Johann Sebastian Bach (1685-1750) - Fugue in B Minor, BWV 544 for organ

With the last great preludes and fugues Bach turns from the exuberant virtuosity of youth to the intellectual virtuosity of maturity. There is a good chance that Bach himself played this music for the first time in Leipzig on 17 October 1727, during a memorial service for Christine, Electress of Saxony and Queen of Poland. This piece is generally considered a musical prayer, conveying not only feelings of sadness, remorse, mourning, but also hope, optimism, and most of all the promise of redemption through help from above.

The sadness is almost tangible in the prelude which is a deeply emotional music. Bach uses here a melancholic lament, which is followed by repetitive great leaps in the pedal, as if you have to keep reminding yourself of what has happened. The fugue completes this musical prayer with the suggestion of moving forward through hope and divine help.
