

Good evening ladies and gentlemen,

Guten Abend zehr ge-hehrte Gäste und Herr Präsidentt. Ich heiße Breanna Gondosch und es ist mir eine große Ehre und Freude vor ihnen als Miss Transylvania 2020 zu stehen. Ich bedanke mich bei alle die gekommen sind, um unseren Trachtenball zu feiern. Ohne Euch alle, würden wir keinen Trachtenball haben.

My name is Breanna Gondosch and I would like to thank you all for being here on what turned out to be a beautiful day and evening. I would like to recognize our honoured guests for being here tonight and joining us at our annual Trachtenball. Without all the hard work, dedication and commitment to this club from our members and volunteers, none of this would be made possible. I am honoured to be standing in front of you all as Miss Transylvania 2020.

I would first like to start off by thanking some important people in my life who have helped to mold and shape me – no literally - stuff me into my tracht tonight. I am thankful for my mother and father, Rob and Kim Gondosch, for their constant support and unconditional love no matter what, as well as my sisters Victoria and Rebecca, and her husband Braden. I feel blessed to have my Omi here this evening, as she will be 96 this April and I grateful I am able to share this moment with her. I would like to thank Erika and Reiny in advance for having to put up with me for this coming year (you're in for a treat! Just Ask my dad Reiny!). I am also excited to share tonight with my extended friends and family, and thank you to Josh Emrich for escorting me in tonight. Finally, I would like to thank our previous Miss, Kenzie Sharratt for representing the club over the past year. You did such a wonderful job as an ambassador and I hope this year has left you with the best memories. You, and all of the former misses have paved and maintained such a high legacy that I strive to carry on this coming year.

So, by now you are probably wondering a little bit about me. I am currently in my third year in the

bachelor of design program at Conestoga College. I chose this career path because I have always had a love for design and creating. I currently work part time at a hair salon as a receptionist in uptown waterloo. In addition to working there, I have also found myself freelancing more and more, honing in on my craft. I also joined the TCK board two years ago as a Digital Communicator.

As a kid, my sisters and I were a part of the Kindergruppe. I remember being downstairs at the old club, making handmade Christmas Crafts or upstairs practicing on stage for whatever event was happening next. Fast forward a few years, and my younger sister Victoria and I would graduate ballroom and then join the dance group, something I always dreamt of. I have been a part of the dance group for 7 years now, and I have been lucky enough to travel to the US and around Europe with our group. This past summer I was given the opportunity to attend a two-week Jügendlager in Austria. That trip created some of my fondest memories, and I was able to learn so much more about my heritage and culture, and I feel grateful that I experienced it with some of my dance group friends. Traveling around Vienna, Salzburg and being hosted in Traun, it felt like a second home.

Gondosch is a common name here at the club so let me clarify which Gondosch family I belong too. I am part of The "Other Gondosch's" - the "pizza Gondosch's". My Omi and Opi are Mary and Mike Gondosch. They had three children, and my father Robert Gondosch, was the youngest of the three. My Tante Trudy, is here with her husband, my Uncle Peter, and my uncle mike and his wife Ann, are unfortunately not here.

There are many people that I wish could be here this evening to share this moment with me but I know they are watching from above. My Opi, my Oma and Opa, Johan and Maria Mathes, my Great Tante Kathi Stoof, and my Nana and Papa Jim and Helen Lacey.

My family comes from a small town called

Mönsdorf, near Bistritz. In 1951 my Omi and Opi came to Canada and settled in Bloomingdale and later moved to Kitchener. My Omi and I often talk about all the sacrifices they all had to go through to come here and what life was like back home in the "old country". I find it so interesting that I have interviewed her almost as if she was under investigation, because I want to know about every little detail. What they did, what they ate, what they wore and who we're related to. I love learning about my heritage, and I hope to one day be able to travel to Romania to see where my Siebenbürgen roots come from.

Once my Omi and Opi moved to Kitchener, they found themselves attending the club and making friends with relatives and people that felt like relatives. My Omi often talks about how the club brought her some of her best friends, and what a feeling to resonate with many years later, because that's how I feel to be a part of the club and a part of the dance group. I have met some of my closest friends through the dance group and I look forward to Sunday practices every week.

We have an amazing year ahead of us, and I look forward to spending time with not only all of you, but using this opportunity to create new friendships within the club and other clubs in the region. I am delighted to be given the opportunity to represent our beautiful Transylvanian heritage with the community and the region.

I believe that collectively the reason that we are all here this evening (may be because you want to see our growing dance group) but more importantly-because you take pride in your heritage. To a lot of us it resonates so deeply, it's something you can't necessarily touch, but you feel it. The feeling of love filling a room, with people who are just as proud to be a Transylvanian Saxon as you. You may not be related to them, or better yet you could very well be, but it's a feeling of heimat. A feeling of home filled with love and laughter. I am lucky enough to know and belong to a community like ours and feel extremely proud to be a Transylvanian Saxon. I hope you all enjoy the rest of your evening.
