

Liebe Mitglieder und Freunde,

As we celebrated New Years with family and friends no one would have thought of what was going to happen to all of us worldwide. "Covid-19" - the disruption and death that this disease has caused across the world will be felt for decades and we still do not have a vaccine/cure. When our ancestors were forced to flee Siebenbürgen in 1944 they saw and heard the sounds of war. Covid-19 is silent and invisible.

All of our planned Saxon on ground celebrations that were to take place after March 2020 have been cancelled. The Heimattag in Dinkelsbühl May 29th to June 1st was done virtually (the personal interaction is missing). The Kulturaustausch with the band and dance group from Traun, Austria visiting Canada and the USA was cancelled. The Heimattag in Salem, Ohio scheduled for July 10th to 12th was cancelled. Going forward into the fall the German Pioneers Day, the Oktoberfest Parade, Trachtenball in Aylmer on November 7th and the Volkstrauertag are all cancelled. The annual Landsmannschaft general meeting will also have to be postponed to 2021. All our Untergruppen practices for the children's group, youth group, band and choir are cancelled. The comradery and personal interaction that these gatherings/practices give us is something that we all miss very much.

We must remain positive as our situation will get better and when our Untergruppen practices and club functions again start up, we need to aggressively rally our people to again attend our functions and support our Siebenbürger Heritage.

On a positive note, Heimattag 2021 has been scheduled to take place in Salem, Ohio on July 9th, 10th and 11th. We hope to also be able to reschedule the Kulturaustausch with the band and dance group from Traun, Austria to coincide with the Heimattag in Salem.

I would like to congratulate Denise Aeling Crawford the newly elected President of the Alliance of Transylvania Saxons in the USA. Denise has been on the ATS board since 1989 and was elected treasurer in 1999. Denise has been involved in and supports our Saxon cultural programs. Denise, the Landsmannschaft in Canada looks forward to working with you on our North American Heimattag and international Jugendlager and Kulturaustausch programs.

I would also like to thank outgoing President Joan Miller-Malue for the good work that she has done. Joan started working at the ATS home office 49 years ago and has been a board member for 45 years. Joan has filled and held many positions; she was hired full-time as Financial Secretary in 1972, became the Home Office Manager on January 1, 1984 and was elected ATS President in May 2016. FALL RECIPES

APPLE FRITTER BREAD

Ingredients

- 1/3 cup Brown Sugar
- 1 tsp Ground Cinnamon
- 2/3 cup White Sugar
- ½ cup Butter, softened
- 2 Eggs
- 1 ½ tsp Pure Vanilla Extract
- 1 ½ cup All-Purpose Flour
- 1 ¾ tsp Baking Powder
- ½ cup Milk (or almond milk)
- 2 Apples, peeled and chopped, tossed with 2 tbsp white sugar and 1 tsp ground cinnamon
- ½ cup Icing Sugar
- 1-3 tbsp Milk

Directions

1. Preheat oven to 350°F. Line a 9x5 inch loaf pan with non-stick spray or parchment paper.
2. Mix brown sugar and cinnamon together in a bowl. Set aside.
3. In a medium-sized bowl, beat white sugar and butter together until smooth and creamy. Beat in eggs one at a time. Add in vanilla extract.
4. In another bowl, whisk together the flour and baking powder and add to the creamed mixture. Stir until just blended. Add milk and stir until smooth.
5. Pour half of the batter into the prepared loaf pan, then half of the apple mixture and half of the brown sugar and cinnamon mixture. Lightly push apples into batter.
6. Repeat step 5 with the remaining batter, apples and cinnamon sugar. Lightly push apples into batter and swirl the cinnamon sugar using a knife or spoon.
7. Bake for approximately 50-60 minutes, until a toothpick inserted in the centre comes out clean. Allow to cool.
8. To make the glaze, mix the icing sugar with the milk until no lumps remain. Drizzle on top of the cake.

SHREDDED BRUSSELS SPROUT SALAD

Portion size: 4 servings

Ingredients

- 3 tablespoons light mayonnaise
- 2 tablespoons grated Parmesan cheese
- 1 tablespoon lemon juice
- 1 teaspoon Dijon mustard
- 1 teaspoon anchovy paste
- 1 garlic minced
- 1/2 teaspoon Worcestershire sauce
- 1 pinch pepper
- 4 cups shredded Brussels sprouts about 16 sprouts
- 2 tablespoons extra-virgin olive oil
- 2 tablespoons diced prosciutto and/or
- 2 tablespoons diced bacon

Directions

In large bowl, whisk together mayonnaise, cheese, lemon juice, mustard, anchovy paste, garlic, Worcestershire sauce and pepper. Add brussels sprouts, tossing to coat. Set aside.

In skillet, heat oil over medium heat; cook prosciutto or bacon until crisp. Add prosciutto/bacon with oil to sprouts mixture, tossing to combine. Let stand for 10 minutes to allow the sprouts to wilt slightly.

Additional optional ingredients (highly recommended): Roasted butternut cubes, pomegranate arils, diced Honeycrisp apple, toasted pumpkin seeds (pepitas). Can also be prepared with a honey Dijon dressing. (See below)

Honey Dijon Dressing

- 1/3 cup balsamic or apple cider vinegar
- ½ cup olive oil
- 2 tablespoons Dijon mustard
- 1 tablespoon honey
- 1 garlic clove or shallot, minced
- 1 pinch salt and pepper to taste

Whisk vinegar, olive oil, mustard, honey, garlic, salt, and pepper in a bowl.




