



RECIPES

ROASTED LEG OF LAMB

Yield: 8 to 10 servings

Prep Time: 20 min

Cook Time: 1 hr 45 min

Total Time: 2 hrs 5 min

Ingredients:

- 1 (5 to 6) trimmed bone-in leg of lamb
- 4 cloves garlic
- 1 tbsp olive oil
- 1 tbsp chopped fresh rosemary
- 1 tbsp chopped fresh thyme leaves
- 1 tbsp Dijon mustard
- 1 tbsp kosher salt
- 2 tsp ground black pepper

Directions:

Preheat oven to 350 degrees F and line a roasting pan with aluminum foil.

Pat lamb dry with paper towels. Using a sharp knife, score the top side by making shallow cuts all over.

In a small bowl, combine garlic, olive oil, rosemary, thyme, Dijon, salt and pepper.

Place lamb, fat side up, on a rack in the prepared roasting pan. Spread garlic mixture evenly over the lamb, rubbing in thoroughly into the cuts.

Place into oven and roast until it reaches an internal temperature of 135 degrees F for medium, about 1 hr 30 min to 1 hr 45 min or until desired doneness. Let rest for 15 min before slicing.

LEMON SPINACH POTATOES

Ingredients

- Potatoes (about 7 medium potatoes depending on the size of the tray)
- Olive oil

- Salt, Pepper, Oregano and Thyme
- 1 Spanish Onion
- 1 Lemon
- Parmesan cheese
- Spinach

Directions:

Preheat oven to 400 degrees F.

Chop up potatoes and put in a bowl with olive oil then season with salt, pepper, oregano and thyme.

Cut up half an onion and put in bowl with potatoes and mix together then put on a baking tray.

Squeeze half a lemon and add Parmesan cheese and bake for 30 minutes and then flip and bake for another 10 min.

In the last ten minutes of bake time sauté spinach in olive oil.

After the 10 minutes squeeze the other half of the lemon onto the potatoes, add more Parmesan cheese and spinach.

SCHNEEBELLE (SNOWBALLS)

A special form is required to get the shape of the snowball.

Ingredients:

- 125 g (1½ c + 1 tbsp) butter
- 4 tbsp sugar
- 5 eggs + 4 egg yolks
- 2 shot glasses Schnapps
- 2 shot glasses mineral water
- 1000 g (2.2 lb) or 6 cups flour

Directions:

Combine butter and sugar then add last 4 ingredients to make dough.

Roll out the dough and cut into thin strips and with our fingers wrap the dough over the form. Every second piece should be woven tightly over the original. Bake in 1 gallon of hot canola oil.


